\$450 each

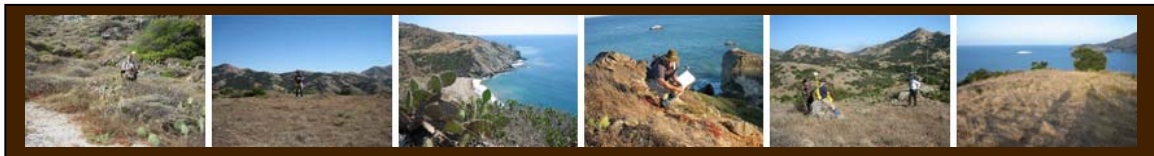
