How do I apply for a scholarship?

What are the scholarship criteria?

- Financial need
- Sincere interest in archaeology and/or Native Heritage Protection
- Demonstrated dedication to working with Native communities or one's own Native community
- Ability to complete all five weeks of the course

What do I need to apply?

- Application form
- Letter of Interest (350 word maximum)
 - Letter should explain how applicant meets the above criteria
- 1-page résumé
- Nomination Letter (from mentor/tribal leader)
 - Letter should describe applicant's dedication to working with Native communities or one's own Native community

Scholarship Availability:
(Tribal Citizens Encouraged)

Three (3) Scholarships:
\$700 each
Open to Non Univ. of CA Students

Two (2) Scholarships:
\$450 each
Open to Univ. of CA Students

Scholarship Deadline:
March 2, 2009

Please note that the scholarship:

- will be paid directly to the course administrators, not to the recipient;
- shall not be applied to the non-refundable deposit required upon registration;
- covers a portion of the field school tuition only, not the entire amount.
